



LEASIDE HOCKEY ASSOCIATION 2026-2027 REFUND POLICY



All withdrawal requests from the Leaside Hockey Association (LHA) must be made via email to the LHA registrar, registrar@leasidehockey.com. Refunds will only be provided, if applicable, as follows:

Prior to and including July 31st, 2026, players may withdraw and receive a refund of their registration fee minus the non-refundable \$200 admin fee.

As of August 1st, 2026, all LHA Registration Purchases are final, and no refunds will be issued for any reason, whether the withdrawal is voluntary or involuntary. Including, but not limited to, withdrawal for illness, results of virus testing or other virus-related conditions and/or quarantine/isolation orders, injury, move of residence, change of mind, date, time, or arena, or any other reasons, a refund will not be issued. Spots are non-transferable.

An LHA registered House League or Select player who transfers to an LHA A or AA team within the season will receive a 100% refund (no admin fee deducted).

For CDS and Select players, once an offer is made and accepted, players are not eligible for a refund, regardless of the date.

A player may only be registered with one hockey association/club at any given time in the Hockey Canada Registry according to GTHL Rules 7.9 & 7.10, as per GTHL Rulebook at <https://gthlcanada.com/rulebook>. Any player found to be registered with multiple clubs/associations and who chooses to withdraw from LHA, or is withdrawn from the LHA by the GTHL, will be subject to the above refund conditions and timelines, including the \$200 non-refundable admin fee.

The LHA reserves the right to modify all programming at our discretion and at any time (including date, session time, and arena). Some reasons for programming modifications include, but are not limited to, health and safety concerns, inclement weather, local virus outbreaks and/or directives from: government, our hockey governing bodies, and/or our arena/rink suppliers.

The modifications may be, but are not limited to:

Changes to the dates, times and/or locations of program sessions.

Reductions in the number of players on the ice or a reduction in ice time.

Substituting hockey skills sessions for competitive games or tournaments.

Temporary cancellations, postponements or rescheduling of program sessions as required.

Cancellation of a program: Should the LHA be unable to provide a program, the LHA reserves the right to cancel the program and provide the participants with a partial refund.

If a program is modified or shut down due to any government or governing body directive and/or for public health or safety reasons, the LHA may still be obligated to fulfill our contractual obligations, and as a result, if we are unable to provide a program, we reserve the right to cancel the program and may provide partial refunds, if contractual obligations allow.

There will be no refunds for missed ice times due to illness or injury.

This policy is binding, non-negotiable and not subject to appeal, dispute, internal hearing or external challenge, legal challenge, or third-party mediation. No exceptions or reviews will be entertained regarding refund denials.

The buyer acknowledges and agrees to the LHA 2026-2027 Refund Policy and the buyer expressly waives any right to challenge, dispute, or appeal the refund policy or any decision made thereunder.
